FINANCIAL IMPACTS OF GOVERNOR'S FISCAL YEARS 2016 & 2017 BUDGET PROPOSAL ON BRECKSVILLE-BROADVIEW HEIGHTS CITY SCHOOL DISTRICT

- Loss of \$444,000 in Foundation Core Aid in FY16
- Loss of \$888,000 in Tangible Personal Property (TPP) Replacement Revenue in FY16
- Total Fiscal Year 2016 loss of \$1,332,000

- Loss of Additional \$431,000 in Foundation Core Aid in FY17
- Loss of Additional \$827,000 in TPP Replacement Revenue in FY17
- Total Fiscal Year 2017 Additional Loss of \$1,258,000

- Total State Revenue Lost in FY16* & FY17 is \$3,922,000 This is the length of the proposed budget

- 3rd highest dollar loss of 31 Cuyahoga County school districts in FY16, FY17, and two-year total

- 7th highest dollar loss of 610 Ohio school districts in FY16

- 6th highest dollar loss of 610 Ohio school district in FY17 and two-year total

- TPP Replacement Revenue at zero in FY17

- Additional \$400,000 in Foundation Core Aid will be lost annually in FY18 AND FY19 (perhaps longer) if language in proposal to phase-out "guarantee" funding remains in law past FY17

- TPP Replacement Revenue – FY15: \$1.7M; FY16: \$800K; FY17: \$0

- Foundation Core Aid – FY15: \$4.7M; FY16: \$4.3M; FY17: \$3.8M; FY18: \$3.4M(est.); FY19: \$3.0M(est.)

- Losses as % of Total Estimated State Revenue – FY15 to FY16: 11.62%; FY15 to FY17: 34.22%

* FY + = Fiscal Year which end on June 30.

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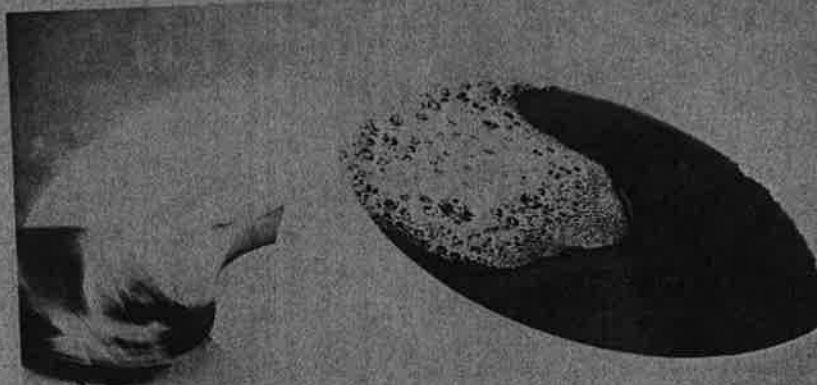
