BBHCSD Grab-And-Go Curbside

The LLS Students of the Year campaign is an initiative in which select students from the Greater Cleveland area participate in a fundraising competition in the hopes of finding a cure for patients with blood cancer. BBHHS Team CURE-ibbean's goal is to raise \$50,000 to benefit LLS in the fight against cancer.

Every three minutes, someone is diagnosed with blood cancer. More than 1.2 million people are living with or in remission from Leukemia, Hodgkin's disease and Myeloma. The Leukemia and Lymphoma Society is working everyday towards the goal of a blood
