Speaker: How to Identify, Stop, & Prevent Bullying

Elementary parents are invited to Chippewa Elementary on **Monday, November 12th at 6:30pm** to hear Amy Young, Psy.D., speak & answer questions about **How to Identify, Stop, & Prevent Bullying.**

Dr. Young is a licensed clinical psychologist at KidsLink Neurobehavioral Center who specializes in the neuropsychological assessment and treatment of infants, toddlers, and school-aged children. Dr. Young has spoken internationally to parents, teachers, and pediatricians on the topic of bullying.

She completed her dissertation research on bullying and peer victimization in Guatemala and obtained her doctorate in Clinical Psychology from Wheaton College in Chicago, IL. Prior to joining KidsLink, Dr. Young was a psychologist in Developmental Medicine at Boston Children's Hospital and an instructor at Harvard Medical School.
